Looking for a gorgeous Christmas knit that is fun to make and bound to be admired and appreciated by friends and family? It's well worth the effort to make handmade gifts and we've rounded up some fun project and product suggestions for you, as well as stocking stuffer ideas for stitching friends (and yourself!), Here's what's popular in our shop for the holiday season, and beyond...

EMMA'S YARN December 2021 Crazy Beautiful Club has arrived! This month's hand-dyed colorway is called "Christmas Sprinkles" and it looks like the toppings on your favorite sugar cookie. It's shown upper left in combination with colorways Stiletto (red) and Take a Hike (green). All are on base "Practically Perfect Sock" (\$26.95, 100 grams, 400 yards, 80% superwash merino/20% nylon, CYCA #2).

We also have a couple of EMMA'S YARN "Smalliday 2021" sets still available. These feature 24 "Practically Perfect Sock" 81-yard smalls individually wrapped to open one each day plus one hand-poured Love+ Leche mint little bee lotion bar, presented in a custom-made EMMA'S YARN drawstring tote bag. Pattern suggestion for this set are *Pinions* by Casapinka (\$10.00, our December mystery knit along), *Flora Daze* by Laura Dobratz (knit, \$6.00) and *Milkweed Leaf Shawl* by Briana K Designs (crochet, \$4.99). All patterns are available as Ravelry Pro downloads through Kathy's Kreations, and we can add them to your Ravelry library for the same price as you pay on Ravelry...

The incredible softness of JUNIPER MOON FARMS "Cumulus" (\$20.50, 100 grams, 251 yards, 94% Mako cotton/6% nylon, CYCA #4) has to be touched to be believed! When it comes to textures, this yarn doesn't mess around. This cloud-like worsted weight yarn with chainette construction is a cotton with a touch of nylon for stability and strength. Perfect for anyone who is wool sensitive. Create cables or textured stitches without adding bulk to your projects, garments, accessories and baby blankets that stand a cut above the rest!

'Tis the season to stuff stockings – when you'd like to give a little something nice to your favorite knitter or crocheter. In addition to FIBER TO FABRIC needle protectors, a batch of new-to-us KNITTER'S PRIDE gadgets are here – row counters, cable needles, repair tools, tape measures and point protectors, to name a few. And, of course, EUCALAN wool wash in trial sizes, travel sizes, and large bottles. You might want to pick up a few to tuck into your own stocking!

ROWAN "Kid Silk Haze" (\$15.95, 25 grams, 230 yards, 70% super kid mohair/30% silk, CYCA #1) is a versatile blend of super kid mohair and fine silk with a beautiful halo. Work with one strand, double it, triple it up or hold it in combination with another yarn for amazing results. It can be knitted or crocheted into a variety of fabrics, from fabulous openwork to elegant dressy tops to fuzzy sweaters. Soft, light, and airy, "Kid Silk Haze" is available in a dazzling array of colors for your stitching pleasure. The luxurious subtle sheen of silk combines with the beautiful halo of kid mohair – we can't get enough of this yarn!

Our final 2021 DREAM IN COLOR December Pop-Up Club selection is here! The festive speckled neutral colorway of "Smoochy Cashmere" (\$34.50, 4 oz., 400 yards, 70% superwash merino/20% cashmere/10% nylon, CYCA #2) pairs beautifully with a variety of rich colors, but is shown here with colorway "Lay A Rose". Suggested pattern support is Theresa Silver's *Harvest Moon Shawl* (\$6.00 Ravelry) – receive a coupon code for 40% off the pattern with purchase of December Pop-Up Club yarn to make this gorgeous shawl...





*** MORE GREAT NEW STUFF ***

One of the quicker gifts to knit are shorty socks, which are having a fashion moment now! *Swell Socks*, designed by Margaux Hufnagel (free pattern on www.berroco.com), uses BERROCO “Ultra Wool DK” (\$12.50, 100 grams, 292 yards, 100% superwash wool, CYCA #3) and “Berroco Sox” (\$14.95, 100 grams, 440 yards, 75% superwash wool/25%nylon, CYCA #2). It makes a delightful stocking stuffer...

Candy Stripe Cowl by Cally Monster of MONSTERKNITS features EMMA’S YARNS “Simply Spectacular DK” (\$26.95, 100 grams, 255 yards, 75% superwash merino/25% nylon, CYCA #3) in two shades for her beautiful holiday season striped neck warmer. It’s a fun and easy slip stitch pattern – fa, la, la, la, lovely!

Kathy’s Kreation is your headquarters for knitted hats! Judging by the most popular patterns during our Friday knit alongs, hats are trending as gifts for this holiday season. Here are some fan favorites, with patterns available through Kathy’s Kreation:

- *Stat Hat*, a Casapinka design (\$5.00 Ravelry Pro download); Kathy Z used BERROCO “Ultra Alpaca Chunky” in two colors & topped it with a TRENDSETTER pom-pom...
- *Corkscrew Hat*, a “Knit Purl Hunter” Michelle Hunter design; Lil G knitted this braided cabled hat with two colors of HiKoo “Simplicity”...
- *Twistmas*, designed by Epace Tricot (free on Ravelry); knit by Lil G with BERROCO “Tiramisu” held with a strand of DREAM IN COLOR “Smoochy” fingering...
- *Tentacula Hat*, designed by Jennie Noto (\$6.00, Ravelry Pro download, shown upper left) is in several knitters’ queues; an intermediate level pattern with a fun unique stitch technique to keep you on your toes. Instructions are written out for worsted and bulky weights with 2 decrease options, making this easy to resize! Bonus version includes directions for super bulky weight yarn, like our newly-restocked, beautifully hand-dyed MANOS DEL URUGUAY Franca” (\$38.50, 150 grams, 114 yards, 100% superwash merino, CYCA #6)...
- *Honesty Hat/Mitts*, designed by Katie De Groff (\$5.50, Ravelry Pro download) is worked in EMMA’s YARN “Simply Spectacular DK” (\$26.95, 100 grams, 255 yards, 75% superwash merino/25% nylon, CYCA #3). Katie chose a folded brim/cuffs, so no worries that your cast on will be too tight. She added some fun welts to showcase an accent color. She took the guesswork out of measuring for a fitted hat, since this is a slouchy style fit, so no measuring! All of these little touches make it a great project for gift knitting...
- *Holly Jolly Hat*, by Rosie Posie Knit Co. (\$8.00, Ravelry Pro download, shown page 7, upper right) was inspired by all the things that make us happy at Christmastime! Hot cocoa, Christmas trees, reindeer, decking the halls with garland, and snow – what could be better? Written and charted in four different sizes – baby, toddler, youth/adult small, and adult large, you can make one for the whole family. There are two different design options – choose from either reindeer or hot cocoa mugs in each of the four sizes...
- *Holiday Baby Hat Pattern*, designed by Ellen and Alexandra Thelin Designs (\$3.00, Ravelry Pro download, shown lower right). This is a fun holiday knit, to be customized as you want. Pattern comes in three sizes, two motif styles. Make it for the favorite baby in your life. Check out Nanette R’s hats in our large holiday window. She knit them for her grandchildren to wear in their holiday photo. So cute and precious with several stripe color options...

*** DECEMBER 2021 KNIT ALONG ***

Sharon from Security (left, hard at work napping) and Casapinka are at it again! They have come up with a brilliant idea for those mini-skein Advent kits, Countdown knits, no reason kits, and leftover scrap yarn – a mystery knit along from December 1–31, 2021 called *Pinions* (Sharon-speak for opinion; pattern \$10.00, Ravelry Pro download available through Kathy's Kreations). Pattern clues will be posted randomly, but there will be 20 clues total.

The design is for a 24" wide X 52" rectangle that will be seamed into a poncho with the option to pick up and knit a cowl neck. Estimated yarn amount is 1400–1600 yards in your desired number of color combinations (plus extra directions for an adjustable length, in case you have more minis or prefer a larger fit). If you have a mini-skein kit, it's based on 20-25 minis that are 80 yards each. BUT, Sharon tells us, you may also use one color, two colors, whatever you like or have! You will need a US size 6 /4mm needle or size of choice preferred for fingering weight yarns.

If the poncho is too big a time commitment for now into winter, we are offering a free URTH YARNS pattern with purchase of yarn to make *Unique Uneek Hat & Fingerless Mitts* (two pair) or one hat in either the slouchy or traditional style. These projects work up quickly and the self-stripping yarn makes them a quite impressive quick-knit...

Please join us in person every Friday during December 2021 from 10:00 am–2:00 pm to work on this or any other project purchased at Kathy's Kreations (yes, we will be open Christmas Eve and New Years Eve for knit alongs). *** UPCOMING CLASSES (Please call us at 724-239-9320 for registration & information) ***

Our ongoing class series, "Let's Knit A Cowl!" with instructor Karen McCullough continues on **Tuesday, December 7, 2021, 1:00 pm–3:00 pm**. This month's project is *Willow Cowl Part One*, designed by Amelia Lyon (Ravelry Pro download available at Kathy's Kreations, \$3.25, shown lower right). This project is perfect for that single skein of sock yarn that you simply don't want to use for socks. Instead, display its beautiful colors around your neck to be in view all day long! This cowl scarf is ideal for dressing up a T-neck top on cold winter nights, or wearing with a jacket. It looks complex, but it is simply a combination of regular knit stitches, a basic decrease, and yarn-overs. Class supplies include 400 yards of fingering/sock weight yarn; one US size 5 circular knitting needle in 16" or 20" length; one stitch marker; circular row or Kacha-Kacha counter; and a tapestry needle. Our shop sample was knit with MANOS DEL URUGUAY "Fino" superwash merino and silk blend, but you may choose any fingering weight yarn from our shelves. The beauty of this pattern is that it looks great with tonals, gradients, variegated, speckles, or dip-dyed yarns. Registration fee is \$20 plus purchase of the pattern. This first class begins with how-to's for getting started with the lower hem edging and basic construction/stitchwork. *Willow Cowl Part Two* is scheduled for **Tuesday January 4, 2022, 1:00 pm–3:00 pm**, with instructions for shaping the neck and completing the top hem edging.

Our *Building Blocks* class series with instructor Karen McCullough continues on **Tuesday, January 18, 2021, 1:00 pm–3:00 pm**. This series was designed by Michelle Hunter specifically to help expand your skills while you navigate through knitting techniques and principles while knitting sampler squares the will eventually make an afghan. This month's topic is *Slip Stitch*. Because every stitch is not worked, slip stitch patterns are quick to knit. Karen will present the how-to's needed to properly execute this interesting technique...



*** UPCOMING CLASSES (continued) ***

For all of you who have been wanting to knit socks (but are afraid to try!), we have an upcoming sock class series for you! By popular demand, instructor Marian Lech is offering a knitting *Yoga Sock* class on **Thursday, January 20, 2022, 10:30 am–12:30 pm**. This is an introductory class for sock knitting – no heels or toes! We have some great self-striping yarns available now, so come early to purchase your yarn. Registration fee is \$20.00. Please call 724-238-9320 to register and for details!

Marian is also planning a sock class series for 2022. Beginning **Thursday, February 3, 2022**, students will begin their journey down the knitted sock highway. She plans to offer classes every month, with some projects geared towards beginner sock knitters, and progressing to some a little more challenging. It is recommended that you have previously taken her *Yoga Sock* class to learn the basics of knitting socks. Class will be held **10:30 am – 12:30 pm**, with additional time afterwards for individual help. More details will be available in our January newsletter update, so stay in touch...

Kathy's Kreations invites you to join us for our 11th annual "Spring Break" Knitting Workshop Weekend, to be held **April 29–May 1, 2022**, hosted by Kathy Zimmerman. We are delighted that Cynthia Spencer of Pine Grove Mills, PA will be our featured instructor for this event (Cynthia's photo, middle right). Kathy first met Cynthia at KNITTER'S DAY OUT, where her classes received rave reviews. More recently, Cynthia was our featured instructor at Spring Break 2021 and our attendees asked us to bring her back to Ligonier, and we are!

Cynthia has spent the past 17 years writing patterns and surrounding herself with knitting, quilting, color, and creativity. Her *Really Clear* pattern series came about as a result of working with hundreds of knitters and learning what they wanted in a pattern. She loves it when knitters understand how to make whatever they want to make!

Cynthia will be teaching the intermediate skill level nine-hour knitting workshop at the Ramada Inn in historic Ligonier, PA with colorwork techniques, intarsia, and Fair Isle/steeking topics. The weekend package includes an after-hours grab & go boxed meal and special shopping time at Kathy's Kreations (Friday evening); an informal meet & greet on Friday evening to get acquainted; an optional Friday evening knit-along; extended lunch break on Saturday with time to shop in the pretty little town of Ligonier, and goodie bags.

Registration is \$275 per person. Overnight lodging is not included and is optional for local participants. The Ramada has set up a special rate for us, so please make your own reservations by calling 724-238-9545. Space is limited on a first-come, first-served basis, and the workshop is already partially filled...

Kathy's Kreations invites you to join us for our 12th annual "Fall Fling" Knitting Workshop Weekend, to be held **September 30, 2022–October 2, 2022**, hosted by Kathy Zimmerman. We are delighted to announce that Keri Fosbrink of Connellsville, PA will be our featured instructor. Kathy first met Keri at the Pittsburgh Knit & Crochet Festival when Keri was still a new stitcher. More recently, Kathy has hosted several YOUGHIOGHENY YARNS trunk shows.

Keri Fosbrink is the owner and dyer behind YOUGHIOGHENY YARNS and has been creating small batch hand dyed yarns since 2015. Playing with color combinations is what she enjoys the most. Each colorway she creates is crafted by hand in her home dye studio. She loves seeing what her yarns grow up to be. Keri's a self-taught knitter and crocheter who also enjoys designing, quilting, cooking, and baking.

Keri will be teaching a nine-hour workshop at the Ramada Inn in historic Ligonier that will help you decode using hand-dyed yarns in your projects. You'll spend the weekend learning how different dye styles work up; exploring how different stitch patterns change when worked with different dye styles, and learning how to match those dye styles to your patterns. The workshop series is open to all skill levels...

*** TIPS, TRICKS AND GIFT IDEAS FROM OUR SHOPGALS & FRIENDS ***

Vina R: Looking for a fun, fast project? Vina recommends Cynthia Spencer's *I Want to be Warm COWL*, a REALLY CLEAR DESIGNS pattern (\$5.00, Ravelry Pro download, shown right). She is working this design for her best friend in one color as a Christmas gift in an eye-catching turquoise shade of our super-soft JUNIPER MOON FARMS "Cumulus" cotton blend, as her bestie is wool-sensitive. Vina-tested and approved!



Stacey R: Stacey has a dedicated trunk to store gifts throughout the year, either handmade or purchased. She can always find where she saved them...

Linda C: When making any adjustments for any pattern, note the needle size you used to get gauge, yarn substitution, and the number of stitches you cast on. Linda writes this information on a sticky note and places everything into a plastic sleeve for future use if needed. She keeps all patterns in a binder...

Gail G: A favorite tip I learned in Ireland from designer Edel MacBride is to tie a small bit of scrap yarn to the center pull of new yarn after winding. It saves the angst of "Where's the end?"

Kim R: Kim uses our Hiya Hiya knitter's safety pins in rainbow colors as markers. At the beginning of the round, she uses a different color marker and makes a chain of connecting pins to keep track of the number of rows worked. She says this is very helpful for cable patterns, particularly the *Legerdemain Scarf* by Jolie Elder...

Karen McC: Before beginning a project, read the pattern through completely. Identify any techniques or abbreviations you don't know and schedule a class or check out a video before you start. A highlighter or LEE highlighter tape is helpful to highlight your size and stitch counts. Plan ahead!


Lil G: Our very resourceful Library Lil came to our rescue when we were decorating our shop windows and in need of faux snow. She bought two very inexpensive pillows at the Dollar Store and we pulled the insides apart for instant faux snow. Be sure to get the polyester fiberfill kind...

Kathy Z: One of our most frequently asked questions at this time of year is "How long should I make a scarf?" My rule of thumb is to make it, whether knit or crocheted, as long as the recipient is tall. For someone who is 5'4", for example, that would be 64 inches long. Current stylish widths are about 8" for adults...

*** CHARITY KNITTING ***

Our customer donations of 100% cotton dishcloths for our winter holiday CARING TREE are now on display in our smaller shop window.
