Dear Stitchers,

Which do you knit or crochet more often: short sleeves or long sleeves? It's probably a safe bet, in view of the recent heat wave, that short sleeves or even tank tops will be the popular choice right now. It's time to cast on cool, cute tees! We all love the versatility of a short-sleeved tee or sleeveless vest because you can wear it on the sunniest of days, then layer it later this year when the weather cools down. Whether you're lounging by the pool or chilling in your backyard, our latest collection will spark your artistic making journey. Let's celebrate the sun-kissed season by casting on something easy and fun to stitch...

You heard it here first! Chevrons are currently a hot fashion trend, although they have long been a stitch pattern staple that adds visual interest to knits. By using decreases and increases to shape the knit fabric, you can create chevrons to break up the standard stripes or textured rows to create beautiful patterns. Explore this technique with MADELINE TOSH's new pattern *Hydration Station Shawl* (see page two), our latest *Spill The Tea* knit along with Marie Green (see page four), Kathy's best-selling pattern ever, *Just One More Row*, or the vintage baby blanket pattern that we've included on page 5. Make waves with chevrons and ripples all summer long...

July not only brings our new knit alongs, but also the Steel Valley Yarn Crawl, Ligonier Block Party and binge-watch watching the Paris Summer Olympics. *** GREAT NEW STUFF ***

Get ready to be inspired as tees, tanks, sleeveless tops and shells are making a comeback, as they always do when summer heats up. Lightweight knit and crochet garments in natural fibers are perfect for staying cool while still showcasing your stitching prowess. We've been trendwatching for you and here are some suggestions for fun products and projects to make, now that the warmest weather in years has arrived...

EMMA'S YARN July 2024 Crazy Beautiful Club selection is a big burst of vivid color (shown upper left). Like fireworks, but so much better! Available here on base "Practically Perfect Sock" (\$28.95, 100 grams, 400 yards, 80% superwash merino/20% nylon, CYCA #2). This makes an ideal choice for one-skeiner travel knitting projects -- you can really rock a pair of perfectly portable vanilla socks or a shawlette!

What's on Kathy's needles? Her latest design is the *Superb Scarf* (pattern \$5.00, shown on page 7, upper right). This unique textured pattern looks like brioche ribbing, but it is actually a much easier clever slip stitch pattern. The scarf also has a tidy edging to help it lie flat. Kathy chose an irresistible shade of MADELINE TOSH "Tosh DK" for this project (\$31.00, 205 meters, 225 yards, 100% superwash merino wool, CYCA #3) -- the color is Superb, in richly toned autumn shades of rust and green. This pattern will premiere in the shop for the Steel Valley Yarn Crawl, along with another surprise scarf in RIVER RAT YARNS, with both being available on Ravelry around mid-August...

When the temps go up, your projects should get smaller and quicker, right? *Three Cheers! A Flag Hat* by REALLY CLEAR DESIGNS (\$5.00,Ravelry Pro pattern download available through Kathy's Kreations, shown page 8, lower right) is perfect knitting to show your support for Team USA during the Summer Olympics and beyond. The bold, graphic stars make this contemporary U.S. flag hat a must-have. So go ahead and knit one (or more), and then on July 4 and during the Summer Games, give three cheers for the red, white and blue! This hat is sized for newborn through adult, so that the entire family can be patriotic together. A headband option is also given. Our shop sample is made with MALABRIGO "Rios" (\$17.50, 100 grams, 210 yards, 100% superwash merino wool, CYCA #4), but you can make it with any yarn that knits at 5 - 5.5 stitches/inch...

We're thrilled to announce that we will be accepting pre-orders for holiday kits from a collaboration between MALABRIGO and BLUE SKY FIBERS (\$77.00, shown page 6, lower left). Arriving this October, the kits features the *Union Cowl* and contain the yarn and pattern for this incredibly versatile garment, specially crafted for the upcoming holiday season! Preorders are available until August 15, 2024, with public release taking place in October. This kit features three luscious skeins of MALABRIGO "Caprino" in shades Teal, Cello, and Poipu -- along with a skein of BLUE SKY FIBERS' new yarn, "Prairie" in color Elderberry. Designed by the talented Bobbi IntVeld, this cowl beautifully showcases the harmonious blend of MALABRIGO's color palette with those of BLUE SKY FIBERS. We're really looking forward to this first collaboration release, and hope that you share in our excitement...

When presented with an exquisite yarn, the eternal question looms: What do I make with it? Here's an idea for MADELINE TOSH's latest Hue of the Moment (named as only Tosh does), Emotional Support Water Bottle. Pattern support is *Hydration Station Shawl* by Lena Skvagerson (\$6.00, shown lower right). According to TOSH: "Languid, chevron lace quenches process knitters' thirst for stitchwork and product knitters' thirst for a delightful finished object". Pattern is free with your purchase of this colorway, available here on base "Twist Light" (\$31.95, 118 grams, 474 yards, 75% superwash merino wool/25% nylon, CYCA #1)...

*** MORE GREAT NEW STUFF ***

If layering pieces are your idea of a favorite to knit and wear, changing up the yarn/fiber can give a sweater a totally new look. *Alanis*, a classic cozy sweater/tee/vest is an easy knit yet still features a few fun details, such as an I-cord edge split hem and an inset pocket with contrasting color pocket lining (pattern \$7.00, download available through Kathy's Kreations Ravelry Pro, shown upper right). Deceptively simple, this relaxed tee has a loose-fitting shape that allows for ease of movement, with a flattering edge at hip length But, knit in BERROCO "Remix", it's great for warm-weather layering. Different results can be achieved different drape and looks due to the fabric created with different yarns. We love the versatility of

We receive a lot of visitors from everywhere during the summer months and we love to hear about what each is making in their particular corner of the knitting/crocheting universe. Recently, Julie D from Minneapolis, MN shared photos of her *Washed Out* shawl, an amazing Joji Locatelli pattern (\$6.00, Ravelry Pro download available through Kathy's Kreations, shown page 8 upper left). This is a stunning asymmetrical triangle wrap with faded stripes and lace, perfect for summer. A faded progression of three fingering weight yarns works well, but it is also very striking in different combinations, faded or not. It would look great in EMMA'S YARN "Super Silky" (\$31.00, 100 grams, 400 yards, 80% superwash merino/20% silk, CYCA #2). The stripes in this pattern will make your colors melt together as you make your way to the final and most stunning part of this project: The lace edging.

this short-sleeved tee top because you can add a layer underneath later this year when the weather cools down. Worked in worsted weight 100% Berroco "Lanas" (\$11.50, 100 grams, 219 yards, 100% wool, CYCA #4), it's perfect for Fall and Winter layering over a long-sleeved shirt. Worked in worsted weight 100% Berroco "Lanas", it's perfect for Fall and Winter layering over a long-sleeved shirt. It's nice to have a handknit tee that transcends seasons...

Hei by Olga Buraya-Kefelian would make an easy, breezy addition to your warm weather wardrobe (\$6.00, Ravelry Pro pattern download available through Kathy's Kreations). The word hei is Japanese for "fence" or "wall". The grid of this textured snood reminded the designer of a fence latticework and is achieved by working staggered motifs of ribbing and eyelets. Both provide positive and negative space for a densely knit fabric that transforms into 3-D surface design with plenty of stretch and styling possibilities. WONDERLAND YARNS "Blossoms" (\$45.95, 4 oz., 344 yards, 100% superwash merino, CYCA #3) sport weight cakes on base "Mad Hatter" is a gradient yarn that would be fabulous for this project or work it in an ombre to add playfulness through color to this accessory...

Our May 2024 knit along featured a lovely neck warmer designed by Laura Dobratz, *Lima Cowl*. And she has followed it up with a spectacular summer pullover, *Lima Tee* (\$7.00, Ravelry Pro pattern download available through Kathy's Kreations, shown lower left, modeled by Emma of Emma's Yarn, Laura's daughter). This is a top-down yoked tee with an engaging all-over textured pattern that is both enjoyable and easy to remember. It is named after a coffee spot in Fort Collins, CO, and works up quickly using a DK weight yarn.



We will be sipping iced lattes from our local cafe, Abigail's Coffeehouse, in our super adorable tees all summer long -- it will work up quickly over a couple cups of coffee, of course! Instructions are included for adjusting the body and sleeve lengths. Wear it casually over a dress or pair it with jeans for a versatile look. The *Lima Tee* effortlessly combines comfort and style, making it a must-have addition to your wardrobe. It looks great when knit with EMMA'S YARN "Simply Spectacular DK" (\$28.50, 100 grams, 255 yards, 75% superwash merino/25%nylon, CYCA #3), a gorgeous 4-ply DK weight yarn perfect for just about any project. It feels very soft and luxurious and shows color so beautifully...

Marie Greene of OLIVE KNITS is hosting a *Spill The Tea* 4-day knit along starting July 3, 2024 (shown upper left, \$12.95 Ravelry Pro download pattern available through Kathy's Kreations). Relax, you DON'T have to do it in 4 days! Easy, breezy lace details and colorful contrasts work together to create the perfect splash of color for this delightful V-neck top. *Spill The Tea* is perfect for summer evenings or for layering in cooler weather -- it's an all-season design that you can wear year-'round. This sweet little tee shirt/vest

is worked with three colors of sport weight yarn. With a soothing yoke of stockinette, a bit of clever construction, a timely modern silhouette, and a fun yarn choice, this tee will be a go-to all summer long. One of the recommended yarns for this cute tee chevron pattern project is our DK weight, two-ply MANOS DEL URUGUAY "Sami" (\$29.95, 100 grams, 273 yards, 100% wool, CYCA #3), and we invite you to knit along with us. Choose your yarn from our collection and come knit with us every Friday in our air-conditioned class area throughout July 2024 from 10:00 am - 2:00 pm. Work on this, or any other project purchased here at Kathy's Kreations (we're crochet friendly, too!). If you can't join us in person, please post your progress on our Ravelry page, We Love Kathy's; Instagram (#kathyknitz) or Facebook (kathy's Kreations; Ligonier, PA).

It's mystery knit along time again and CASAPINKA's *The Sharon Road Trip* shawl MKAL will begin July 12, 2024. There will be 6 clues over a period of six weeks. This will extend through our Yarn Crawl, and right into the summer Olympics and August. Choose four skeins of fingering weight yarns from our collection (we have combos to spark your creativity). Four colors of tonal yarn were used, with one of them a contrast color. Don't make the other colors too "blendy", as you don't want them to fade into each other. However, a gradient will work, just ensure you can see the difference between the shades. Variegated can work also, but realize that if it blends into one of the other colors, you may need to switch it up but it is probably best for color B. Kathy is working our shop sample with MADELINE TOSH "Tosh Sock" and she's excited because the dyers at Maddy Tosh validated the choice of her color selection (yippee!) and hand-dyed it just for us. Please remember that this is a mystery knit-along so we can't tell you too much, but past summer MKALs always have been fabulous!

*** FALL FLING NEWS ***

Our 13th annual "Fall Fling" Knitting Workshop Weekend will be held **September 27**— **September 29, 2024**, hosted by Kathy Zimmerman. It promises to be a special autumn event in beautiful Ligonier Valley.

Kathy chose MADELINE TOSH "Tosh DK" in colorway weighted blanket for her class sample (shown upper right). Additional supplies include US size 5 needles of your choice for working in the round -- dpns, two circs, FlexiFlips, Magic Loop, 9" circ, etc.-- and 6 stitch markers. Registration fee is \$20.00 plus yarn and purchase of Ravelry Pro download pattern \$6.00. Please call 724-238-9320 to save a space...

We are thrilled to announce the upcoming launch of a brand new yarn base. We will be Introducing DREAM IN COLOR "Smooshy Yak" in September, the Yak cousin to our top-selling "Smooshy Cashmere". This fingering weight yarn features an exquisite blend of 80% superwash merino wool, 10% nylon, and 10% yak. Designed for exceptional stitch definition, its optimal twist brings out the best in your work, making it a dream for shawls, scarves, and any project you'd love to wear close to your skin. Pre-orders now being accepted -- ask for details. Shown lower left with *Another Door Opens Shawl* by Lena Skvagerson in colors Way Cool, Bedtime, and Water Dragon (shown lower left)...

We can't spill all the beans yet, but our September knit along *Lehigh Shawl* is in the planning stages, still under wraps. We can tell you that it will be a long triangular shape worked from the triangle point, with increases worked each side on every row to the top edge. It uses two shades of our top-selling MALABRIGO "Rios" yarn and is a tried-and-true design from the fabulous Melanie Berg...

*** CHEVRON BABY BLANKET (not shown) ***

Everything old is new again! We were inspired by a retro vintage pattern with onceagain trendy chevrons shared by our friend Susan Z and updated by us:

MATERIALS: 1260 yards worsted weight yarn (suggested yarn BERROCO "Comfort", 6 skeins); US size 8 circular knitting needle 32" length; stitch markers; tapestry needle for finishing FINISHED SIZE approx. 30" X 48"

GAUGE: 6 stitches = 1"

NOTES: Slip markers every row as you come to them. If you wish to work a longer blanket, more varn may be needed.

INSTRUCTIONS: Cast on 180 stitches. Knit 8 rows. On last row, knit 6, place marker, knit to last 6 stitches, place marker, knit 6.

Row 1: Knit 6, slip marker, knit 2 together four times; *(yarn over, purl 1) eight times, knit 2 together eight times; repeat from *across row ending with (yarn over, purl 1) eight times, knit 2 together four times, slip marker, knit 6.

Row 2: Knit across.

Row 3: Knit 6, slip marker, purl to next marker, knit 6.

Row 4: Knit across.

Rows 5 - 24: Repeat rows 1 - 4 five more times.

Rows 25, 27 & 29: Knit.

Rows 26, 28 & 30: K6, slip marker, purl to last 6 sts, slip marker, knit 6. Repeat these 30 rows until piece measures approx. 47" or desired length, ending with row 30 of the pattern.

Knit 8 rows. Bind off all stitches. Weave in ends with tapestry needle.

*** JUNE 2024 KNIT ALONG (KAL) ***

One of the best things about being a knitter or crocheter is that we are a community of makers.
