Dear Stitchers,

"Starting our engines" for the Maryland Road Trip last month has us thinking that a bright and colorful new project is a happy travel companion, whether your destination is to the beach, the mountains or anywhere in between. No matter where you find yourself, upbeat knitting and crocheting styles are sure to uplift your mood and help you to enjoy every moment. Garment silhouettes are going to be boxy and cropped, evoking a 50s and 60s design aesthetic. The cutest thing to knit yourself this summer is a short-sleeved, capsleeved, or entirely sleeveless tank or cardi. Think: *The Birdwatcher* design by Casapinka!

Warmer weather stitching has us dreaming of lightweight lace patterns. Summer garments are typically more open and airy, and this season is no exception. Full-on lace, lace details, lace sleeves, and yokes with lace — they're all heavily featured this summer. Lace looks a lot more intimidating than it actually is. The combination of decreases and increases creates beautiful surface texture, but it's surprisingly logical and orderly. Try starting with something small and working slowly. Ideal "starter" knitting projects are CHURCHMOUSE Lace-back Fingerless Gloves (little hand warmers) or Diagonal Lace Wrap & Scarf (in two gauges), while crocheters might enjoy BERROCO Anemone with its easy shell pattern stitch.

Whatever your stitching pleasure as we welcome summer, Kathy's Kreations can help you find an appropriate pattern for your skill level and interest. Let's dive in!

# Emma's Yarn CEATH SEATHFUL CLUB

#### \*\*\* GREAT NEW STUFF \*\*\*

Knitwear is a perennial wardrobe staple year-round. However, in warmer weather, we see brighter palettes, lighter fabrics, and sunnier accessories. Knitwear is the No. 1 most important fashion trend for spring/summer 2021. Maybe it is the influence of Taylor Swift's *Cardigan* single from her *Folklore album*, but pretty cropped cardigans are having a huge fashion moment. Here's what else is trending...

In case you {May} be wondering, EMMA'S YARN Crazy Beautiful Club selection for May 2021 is a shade that will make you feel instantly happier and ready to take on summer projects! We've got it in base "Practically Perfect Sock" (\$26.95, 100 grams, 400 yards, 80% merino wool/20% nylon, CYCA #2, shown upper left). Other recent arrivals from EMMA include *Noncho* kits for our May 2021 Casapinka knit along on base "Simply Spectacular DK" (kit price varies by size; \$132.50 for sizes medium to XL) and rainbow shades of black shadowed "Beautifully Basic" (\$26.95, 100 grams, 100% superwash merino, CYCA #2)...

We found a great new gadget that is a must-have for any knitter's project bag! Ann Budd's *Handy Gauge Ruler* (\$5.00) features outlines of black (for light-colored yarn) and white (for dark-colored yarn) knitted stitches in 11 gauges, ranging from 4 stitches/inch to 9 stitches/inch in one-half-stitch-per-inch increments. Simply move the ruler across your knitting until you find the markings that match the stitches in your knitted fabric to get a good estimate of your stitch gauge! Use it to determine whether you're on track with a work in progress or to check the gauge of something you've already completed. This ruler will help you figure out your stitch gauge quickly and efficiently. Perfect for knitters who hate counting stitches...

There seems to be a baby boom going on in southwestern PA. If you're looking for a gender-neutral idea, we recommend *Brooklyn Rib Baby Blanket* (\$5.99, Ravelry Pro download, shown page 8 upper left) designed by DOUBLE THE STITCHES DESIGNS. Knit with our soft-as-a-cloud cotton worsted JUNIPER MOON FARM "Cumulus" (\$20.50 solids / \$23.50 variegated, 100 grams, 248 yards, 94% cotton/6% nylon, CYCA #4). Available in either car seat or crib blanket sizes, this is a simple design filled with knits and purls in an easy-to-remember pattern stitch. This beautifully textured blanket is perfect for any recipient...

Warmer weather signals that it's time for knitting and crocheting with cotton. One of our favorite patterns that looks great on everyone is the *Lourdes* top from BERROCO YARNS (\$8.00, Ravelry Pro download, shown page 5, upper right). This simple tee gets a lift from an eye-catching stitch pattern. The boxy shape is flattering to every figure. *Lourdes* is knit with the ultimate yarn for summer garments, "Pure Pima Cotton" (\$11.50, 100 grams, 219 yards, 100% pima cotton, CYCA #4). This 4-ply yarn has the perfect amount of twist and a matte finish, loved for its superior softness and exquisite stitch detail...


There's a fresh new design from our own Kathy Zimmerman, *Flamingo Road* (\$4.00, shown lower right). Kathy was inspired by SKACEL COLLECTION'S HiKoo "Simpliworsted" Color Of The Year, fabulous flamingo. The pattern features a ridged slip stitch pattern that resembles tiny flamingo legs crossing a road, with bobble "nests' at each end. The scarf is worked in two pieces, then joined at the center back with a 3-needle bind-off technique. The pattern is also available for download purchase at the Kathy Zimmerman Store on Ravelry...

#### \*\*\* MORE GREAT NEW STUFF \*\*\*

The last selection of the DREAM IN COLOR spring Pop-Up Club season is here, and this gorgeous shade was inspired by ocean creatures and the Kelp Forest (shown right). We love seeing the photo inspirations behind Veronica Van's color schemes, especially on the "Smooshy Cashmere" base (\$34.50, 100 grams, 400 yards, 70% superwash merino/20% cashmere/10% nylon, CYCA #2). We still have



some previous colorways available, and the Pop-Up Club series will start up again coming n September...

The Maryland Road Trip Mystery Knit Along with Cynthia Spencer and Valerie Reed kicked off on April 17, 2021 for LYS Day. We have a few kits remaining from BAAH Yarns in their splendid "La Jolla" fingering weight superwash merino wool (\$125.00 per kit). Hurry in to see them before we sell out or view them at roadtripmystery.com. They are so pretty! Warning — it's hard to pick just one, the vibrant colors are all spectacular! Speaking of BAAH YARNS "La Jolla" shades, we also have received some beauties like Seashell, Marigold, Pink Sand and Orange Amber that would look stunning in this project...

Stretchy, vibrant and colorful, self-patterning UNIVERSAL YARNS "Bamboo Pop Sock" (\$9.50, 100 grams, 492 yards, 37% cotton/8% PBT/55% bamboo, CYCA #2) is wool-free, making it an ideal choice for those who are wool-sensitive. Light and breezy, it is great for cheerful socks, accessories, baby knits and more! Our shopgal Marian recommends this yarn for yoga and pedicure socks...

PLYMOUTH YARNS "Done By Mondays Afghans" Book 638 (\$7.50) is a collection of 15 full-size afghans for knitters of any skill level. Each of the designs uses exactly 10—100 gram balls of PLYMOUTH "Encore Worsted" and a US #13 32" circular knitting needle. The yarn is used double stranded throughout for speedy knitting. Each afghan is approximately 45" X 50" in size...

The KATRINKLES mini-tool 1" acrylic gauge rulers with our custom logo RULE! These handy square tools on a keychain (\$10.50) are used for a quick gauge swatch measure in knit or crochet in any type of yarn. Simply hold the tool up against your work and count how many stitches fit inside the cut out square (along the bottom edge for stitches and the side edge for row gauge). The bottom measurements are in inches and centimeters are marked on the left side, making this ruler universal for all fiber artists..

We tend to choose small accessories for our warmer weather "take-along" or porch knitting. *Dust Devils* by designer Laura Aylor (\$6.00 Ravelry Pro download, shown lower left, stitched by our knitting friend Gail G) are ideal portable projects. These unique mitts are worked in the round, back and forth, in the round, back and forth, and in the round again — making shaped mitts with thumb gussets without ever cutting your yarn. Gail tells us that

they are not difficult, but it is very important that you pay attention and read carefully!

Gail chose our NORO "Kureyon (\$12.50, 50 grams, 110 yards, 100% wool, CYCA #4) and suggests standard double-pointed needles for this project. Other self-striping yarns suitable for this projects include PLYMOUTH "Gina" (\$6.95, 50 grams, 109 yards, 100% wool, CYCA #4), BERROCO YARNS "Millefiori" (\$15.50, 100 grams, 186 yards, 50% wool/50% acrylic, CYCA #4) and BERROCO YARNS "Sesame" (\$16.95, 100 grams, 230 yards, 43% wool/39% acrylic/9%cotton/9% nylon, CYCA #4)...

#### \*\*\* MAY 2021 KNIT ALONG (KAL) \*\*\*

Designer Casapinka is once again supporting Local Yarn Stores this month with a free (with yarn purchase) pattern! The *Noncho* pattern is written for 7 sizes and will be released on National Bubble Tea Day, April 30, 2021. You'll receive a code from us to download the pattern from Ravelry which can be redeemed ONLY from April 30—May 2, 2021.

Casapinka designed the *Noncho* in EMMA'S YARN "Simply Spectacular DK" on US 6 needles, with the "Securrity" combo for her model (shown photo,

upper left). We will have several options from EMMA's YARN, BAAH YARNS, and DREAM IN COLOR, plus "Boba" stitch markers from HDC (\$10.95, set of 5). Sizes are based on the chest circumference and required yardage will vary with each size. The pattern is also written for fingering weight yarn using US size 4 knitting needles. It may also be worked in a two-color option.

Let's Knit A Hat! is a fun skill-building opportunity offered by instructor Karen McCullough on Tuesday, May 4, 2021; 1:00 pm - 3:00 pm. This month's topper is a spiral openwork Top-Down No Math Hat, designed by Suzyn Jackson Gonzalez. Class supplies include one ball of chunky or worsted weight yarn and two corresponding knitting needles in 16"-20" length. Karen will demonstrate working in the round with two circular needles, beginning at the crown. Pattern is included with the class registration fee of \$20.00.

Our *Building Blocks* class series continues on **Tuesday, May 18, 2021; 1:00 pm -3:00 pm** with instructor Karen McCullough. This knitting series was designed by Michelle Hunter specifically to help grow your skills while you navigate through major knitting techniques and principles while knitting sampler squares to eventually make an afghan. Each class will focus upon a technique to broaden your understanding. This month's topic is *Cables*, dramatic twisted stitches that are the result of knitting stitches out of order. Registration fee is \$20.00 per session plus purchase of book and yarn from Kathy's Kreations. Want to learn more? Please give us a call at 724-238-9320 for information on any of our upcoming classes or to schedule a private knit or crochet lesson...

Always been a little curious about brioche knitting? Or, maybe you know just a little, but not quite enough? We've got two classes coming up with instructor Marian Lech that are just the answer. Let's Do Brioche, Part 1 on Saturday, May 22, 2021, 12 noon—3:00 pm, is an introductory class for those who have never done brioche or need a refresher. In this class, you will learn about terms, stitches and basic brioche techniques. Student supplies include swatching yarn in worsted weight and US 7 or 8 knitting needles (straight or circular), or purchase supplies here before class. Class fee \$20. Limit 4 students...

Let's Do Brioche, Part 2: Channeled Colors Brioche Cowl is scheduled for Saturday, June 5, 2021, 12 noon—3:00 pm. This beautiful two-color cowl (shown right) is worked in the round with two colors of yarn. Purchase worsted weight or light bulky yarn from Kathy's Kreations for this project (500 yards main color, 500 yards contrast color; suggested yarns HiKOO "Kenzington" and MANOS "Maxima"), plus bring US size 10 24" circular needles for a scarf length or 40" for an infinity loop. There is pre-class homework; a working knowledge of brioche is need to take this class. Class fee \$20. Limit 4 students...



#### \*\*\* READING LACE KNITTING CHARTS \*\*\*

Interweave Knits tells us: "Lace is the perfect fabric for unpredictable spring weather. It's so lightweight and lovely, and it adds just a touch of warmth. Not to mention, lace motifs are full of florals and leaves; perfect for this time of year!" The lovely *Lourdes* top from BERROCO is shown at right and is suitable for a first lace or first sweater knitting project.

Lace charts can be challenging, whether it's what a symbol means, how to read the chart, or what technique is being described. For example:

- What is a "no stitch"? Some charted patterns have changing stitch counts, so a "no stitch" symbol is a space holder on the chart. When you come to a "no stitch" symbol on the chart, just ignore it and skip over that square. Go to the next stitch that has a square and work that instead. Sooner or later, the square will be filled in.
- Does the chart have a box around some stitches? That's a pattern repeat box. The stitches within that box are to be repeated.
- Pay attention that you are working in the correct direction. If you are working back and forth in rows, read right-side rows from right to left and read wrong-side chart rows from left to right (just as you are knitting them). Usually, the odd-numbered rows are right-side rows, and the even-numbered rows are wrong-side rows. When working in rounds, EVERY chart row is read as a right-side row, from right to left.

#### \*\*\* COTTON FOR SUMMER \*\*\*

This just in! SCHOEPPEL "Cotton Ball" (\$22.50, 100 grams, 459 yards, 100% cotton, CYCA #2) yarn has arrived on our shelves! This long-staple cotton, sourced from Greece, is dyed in Shadow Colors through the use of a new water and environmentally friendly technology. This yarn features a cool hand and superior drape. Ask to see our shop model, *Pebble Beach Shawl*, a design by Helen Stewart (\$6.91, Ravelry Pro). This crescent-shaped wrap is perfect for keeping off chilly evening breezes. It drapes beautifully across the shoulders and the picot bind off gives a polished finish. *Pebble Beach* is the perfect travel knitting project!

#### \*\*\* KNITWEAR TRENDS FOR SUMMER 2021 \*\*\*

According to the website *Brunette From Wall Street*, here are key knitwear trends for Summer 2021. Feminine pink and lilac are very popular shades to choose.

- "Strappy knitwear" is a new trend that is rising fast probably faster than you can tie the tie of a fashionable cardigan around your waist...
- Vests a cropped, pretty vest is a must-have you'll want to add to your wardrobe
- Cardigan Set although popular for a while, knitwear designers keep making them pretty; cropped cardigans are the biggest trend; puff sleeve cardigan
- Short cardigan with a collar (exaggerated collar, lace collar, sweetheart neckline)
- Knitted athletic top
- Knit polo shirt
- Classic fitted tank top

On Saturday morning, we'll work our way through the basics of reversible cables. On Saturday afternoon, we'll look at a center-out cast-on and a Y-increase. Participants will be able to design their own hat with a reversible cabled brim. On Sunday, we'll cover a special technique called *Knit Faster With Combination Knitting*.

Decription from Jolie: "We'll enjoy a weekend of working reversible cables and knitting faster. On Saturday morning, we'll learn how to make easy reversible cables. You'll be surprised you haven't seen this technique before, it is so simple and satisfying. On Saturday afternoon, we'll design our own top-down hat with a reversible cabled brim. This is a great way to use single skeins; perfect if you make hats for charity. The finished hat is warm and fits a wide variety of head sizes. On Sunday, we'll learn tricks for knitting faster while improving our tension at the same time. To see the projects, go to Ravelry and look at Legerdermain Scarf and Casquerade Hat and Jolie's Cable Helmet Hat.

The weekend package includes an after-hours boxed meal and special shopping time at Kathy's Kreations (Friday evening); an informal meet & greet on Friday evening to get acquainted; an optional Friday evening knit along; morning coffee breaks and two lunches at the Ramada; classes Saturday and Sunday; extended lunch break on Saturday with time to shop in the pretty town of Ligonier and goodie bags.
