Discover a range of knitting and crocheting patterns and the latest yarns for both holiday gifting and the winter months ahead here at Kathy’s Kreations. Be inspired...

In our opinion, cashmere is the softest, most luxe yarn on earth. Winter should never be without it. The DREAM IN COLOR November Pop-Up Club selection on base “Smoochy Cashmere” has arrived (\$34.50, 4 oz., 400 yards, 70% superwash merino/20% cashmere/10% nylon, CYCA #2, shown upper left) and it seems that every month’s shade is prettier than the last. The November teal shade is no exception. About her inspiration for this shade, hand dyer extraordinaire Veronica Van says: “Quite a few years back I fell down a rabbit hole where I became obsessed with the Antarctic explorer, Ernest Shackleton. I was so inspired by his leadership style. As a manager I still try to follow his rule of not asking any employee to do something I wouldn’t/haven’t done myself. It was so impressive how he valued each and every crew member. His book, *South*, was packed with so many amazing moments but one thing I will never forget was his multiple descriptions of icebergs. I had no idea there were so many colors and types of ice. This month’s color is dedicated to all the amazing caring leaders out there!”

Let’s welcome fall with tweed yarns, which offer a great way to create basic yet colorfully classic garments. Tweed yarns feature tiny bits of color (neps), that add a touch of interest to any design. This month, we’re highlighting HiKOO “Kenzington” (\$24.50, 100 grams, 208 yards, 60% New Zealand merino wool/25% nylon/10% alpaca/5% silk noils, CYCA #5), a lofty chainette-construction tweed yarn that’s perfect for warm fall sweaters and accessories. For a limited time, we are offering a free copy of Heather McVickar’s *Coastline Cowl* (regularly \$6.00 Ravelry Pro download) with your purchase of two skeins of “Kenzington”. This slip-stitch project with trendy fringed edge knits up quickly on US 11 needles and is bound to be a favorite go-to for gifting! It’s definitely time for tweed...

BERROCO “Vintage Chunky” is designer Casapinka’s yarn of choice for our newest KAL, *Sharon’s Glamping Blanket* (see KAL photo & info on page 4). This machine washable blend (\$9.50, 100 grams, 136 yards, 52% acrylic/40% wool /8% nylon, CYCA #5) features a wide color range, an incredibly soft feel and yardage that goes on and on. Its unique fiber blend makes laundering a breeze and it is perfectly suited for easy care garments for both children and adults (and now, pet blankets, too! Isn’t that right, Sharon?)...

November in the Laurel Highlands means final leaf peeping and walks in the woods feeling the crunch of fallen leaves under our feet. November for Floridians like EMMA, however, means walks along crowdless and peaceful beaches with beautiful sunsets in 80 degree weather. EMMA’S YARNS November 2020 Crazy Beautiful Club on base “Practically Perfect Sock” (\$26.95, 100 grams, 400 yards, 80% superwash merino/20% nylon, CYCA #2, shown lower right) captures that feeling. Our picks of the pack are Martin’s amazing ponchos – *Skibo* (shown upper right), *Cawdor*, and *Savoy* – all winners!

We have recently received new gradient shades of “Rockshelter Sock” (\$30.50, 100 grams, 100% superwash merino wool, CYCA #2) and are pleased to introduce to our shelves “Cross Creek Sock” (\$30.50, 100 grams, 468 yards, 75% superwash merino / 25% nylon, CYCA #2). Hand-knit socks are a gift of love, so don’t forget to show yourself a little love while you’re at it...

While you are checking your holiday gift list, don’t forget to add any new members to the family who will appreciate their own handknit Christmas stocking! LISA KNITS COLLECTION offers two colorful “tried-and-true” but easy-to-knit patterns (\$5.00 each): “Christmas Stripes” ST-001 and “A Fair Isle Christmas” ST-002. We also stock traditional intarsia knitted Christmas stockings from ANN NORLING (\$10.50): pattern 1013 (snowman, reindeer, Santa, Nutcracker), pattern 1018 (angels, Santa face, tree with presents, Noel), pattern 1019 (snowflakes, wreath, bear, fireplace) and pattern 1020 (snowflake)...

For knitters and crocheters on the go, we recommend that you have a tote bag with a project and tools ready to pick up whenever you hit the road. We have a collection of most-needed tools like stitch markers, snips, coilless pins, a row counter and point protectors in a handy little tin from THE KNITTING ZONE (\$15.50)...

Colorwork expert and designer Cynthia Spencer will be our guest instructor for Spring Break April 16–18, 2021. Cynthia has just released a new REALLY CLEAR DESIGNS pattern called *Brioche Starter Cowl* (\$4.50, Ravelry Pro download, shown lower left). She tells us that it is a small project, perfect for gift-making (quick and easy, but wearable and cute!).

It’s knit in the round, which is easier to do in brioche. As the name implies, it is a good beginner’s cowl. This pattern has flexible sizing. Cynthia provides a chart which gives directions and cast-on numbers for different sizes and yarn weights. Use two colors of worsted, heavy worsted or bulky yarn to create interest in your brioche stitch, and a little garter to give yourself a break. Cynthia added some garter stitch “lifeline” rounds. If the brioche goes awry for some reason, you simply take it back to the garter stitch (an added sense of security!)...

*** NOVEMBER KNIT ALONG (KAL) ***

At the request of one of our knitting friends, Donna G, we have chosen designer JOJI LOCATELLI's *Terra Shawl* (shown upper left, \$5.50 Ravelry Pro download) for our November 2020 knit along. About this openwork shawl, Joji says: "I love this shawl so much, especially the fact that it's SO QUICK to make, and you can adjust how small/big you want it to be. It is a continuous repeat that you can keep making over and over until you run out of yarn." This shawl is knit with US size 8 needles and approximately 462 yards of DK weight yarn. Kathy has chosen two skeins of DREAM IN COLOR

"Cosette DK" merino/cashmere blend in colorway clockwork heart for our shop sample.

There's yet another encore for fans of Casapinka and SFS (Sharon from Security, her cat). Next up is *Sharon's Glamping Blanket knit* with four colors of BERROCO "Vintage Chunky" -- let the shenanigans go on! The pattern is available through Kathy's Kreations (\$7.00, Ravelry Pro download) and continues through November 2020. We'll do our best to help you get started with the pattern and yarn selection. Kathy's Kreations is one of the yarn shops doing a test knit of this project and we can vouch that it is a fun project! Blanket is shown lower right in Cat Size (18" X 22") at lower right, but is also sized for baby/small dog/portly cat (24" X 36"), dog/lap (35" X 44"), and sofa (46" X 58"). "Vintage Chunky" is the perfect blanket yarn as it knits up quickly on US size 10 knitting needles, is easy to wash and is comfy for snuggling. If you are unable to stop in, Kathy's Kreations can also arrange to have yarn for this project sent to you as a shipment directly from Berroco headquarters with a \$7.00 shipping charge, so call us at 724-238-9320. We love the enjoyment that Sharon and Casapinka have brought to the knitting world during this challenging time for all of us. Sharon's knitting saga continues...

Let's Knit A Hat! is a brand new learning opportunity offered from instructor Karen McCullough beginning **Tuesday, November 3, 2020; 1:00 pm - 3:30 pm**. This year-long series of skill-building techniques will include cast ons, colorwork, stitch patterns, shaping and more as you learn to make a different hat in each session -- it's a year of hats! We'll start with a basic hat knit in the round, and learn how to do stripes, decreases for crown shaping, finishing, as well as ideas for fun "toppers" like knitted pompoms. Our first class will be a basic hat, *Ebullience*, shown upper right. Class supplies include one skein of worsted weight yarn in two different colors, US size 6 & 8 circular needles in 16" length and pattern will be provided free. Registration fee is \$20.00 per session plus purchase of yarn from Kathy's Kreations...

The *Building With Lace* year-long class series based on the phenomenal book by Michelle Hunter and taught by instructor Karen McCullough begins again. Take your knitting to the next level while you master lace knitting one section at a time. Each class will focus upon a technique to broaden your understanding. The sessions include classic favorites, original designs, and even some beading. *Building With Lace* begins on **Tuesday, November 17, 2020; 9:30 am - 12:30 pm** and continues on the third Tuesday morning of each month. *** STRIPED HAT FOR THE FAMILY ***

It's time to keep everyone's heads warm, so Kathy designed this basic beanie for the entire family. It features a 2X2 ribbed cuff, a stockinette body that's great for striped options, a neatly decreased crown and is worked seamlessly in the round.

SIZES: Baby (toddler/child/ adult in parentheses)

FINISHED HEAD CIRCUMFERENCE: approximately 14-1/2 (17, 19, 21-1/2)"

GAUGE: 5 sts / 7 rounds = 1" on body of cap

MATERIALS: BERROCO "Comfort Worsted" one ball each in two contrasting

colors; US size 7 (4.5 mm) circular knitting needle 16" length; US size 7 (4.5 mm) double-pointed needles for crown; one stitch marker; tapestry needle for finishing; one

McPORTER FARMS snap-on pompom. Model shown in red 9750 (CC) and chalk 9700 (MC).

ABBREVIATIONS: CC—contrasting color; k—knit; p—purl; k2tog—knit 2 two together; MC—main color; sts—stitches

DIRECTIONS: With circular needle and CC, cast on 72 (84, 96, 108) sts. Join, being careful not to twist work; place marker for beginning of round. Work in K2, P2 ribbing for 6 (8, 10, 12) rounds. Drop CC. Begin stripe sequence: K 4 rounds MC, K 2 rounds CC, K 2 rounds MC, K 4 rounds CC, K 2 rounds MC, K 2 rounds CC. Cut CC. Continue to knit every round with MC until hat measures 6 (6-1/2, 7, 7-1/2)".

Crown Shaping (continue with MC, change to double-pointed needles when necessary)

Round 1: *K4, k2tog; repeat from * around, k4 —60 (70, 80, 90) sts.

Round 2 and all even-numbered rounds: K.

Round 3: *K3, k2tog; repeat from * around, k3 — 48 (56, 64, 72) sts.

Round 5: *K2, k2tog; repeat from * around, k2 — 36 (42, 48, 54) sts.

Round 7: *K1, k2tog; repeat from * around, k1 — 24 (28, 32, 36) sts.

Round 9: *k2tog; repeat from * around — 12 (14, 16, 18) sts. Cut yarn, drawn through remaining sts, pull up and fasten off. Weave in ends with tapestry needle. Add pompom.

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*** SOUP-BOWL CABBAGE ROLLS ***

This "deconstructed" hearty recipe is from Roz M, who shared it with our Friday KAL group. A fabulous alternative to traditional stuffed cabbage rolls, it is so handy for busy weeknights. It will warm you up from head to toe. Thanks, Roz!

1 lb. lean ground beef (90% lean)

1 garlic clove, minced

1 small head cabbage, chopped

2-1/2 cups water

2/3 cup uncooked long grain rice

1 tbsp. worcestershire sauce

1 tsp. onion powder

1 tsp. dried basil

1/4 tsp. cayenne pepper

1/4 tsp. black pepper

1 can (28 oz.) crushed tomatoes

1/2 tsp. salt

- In a nonstick Dutch oven, cook beef and garlic over medium heat until meat is no longer pink; drain. Stir in the next eight ingredients; bring to a boil. Reduce heat; simmer, covered, until rice is tender, about 25–30 minutes. Stir in tomatoes and salt; heat through. If desired, sprinkle with parmesan cheese. Makes 4 large servings.

She loves it when knitters understand how to make whatever they want to make!

Cynthia will be teaching a nine-hour knitting workshop at the Ramada Inn in historic Ligonier, PA with colorwork knitting topics.

WEEKEND DETAILS

The weekend package includes an after-hours Soup & Sliders party and special shopping time at Kathy's Kreations (Friday evening); an informal meet & greet on Friday evening to get acquainted; an optional Friday evening knit-along; morning coffee breaks and two lunches at the Ramada; classes Saturday and Sunday; extended lunch break on Saturday with time to shop in the pretty little town of Ligonier and goodie bags.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

About *Make A Million Shawl* (shown lower right), Cynthia tells us: "This 'recipe pattern' will allow you to combine different colors and textures to create a beautiful shawl! You can use any type of yarn for this shawl. Start with 3 or 4 colors (all the same weight), and if you need to buy more, you can do that later! Bring a long circular needle two sizes larger than the yarn normally takes. (ex., If you're making this shawl out of fingering weight yarn, you should bring a size 4 or 5 long needle.)" The pattern is *Make A Million Shawl* by Really Clear Designs, and will be provided by Kathy's Kreations.

There is nothing like Fair Isle to give the knitter the creativity to combine vibrant colors with stunning patterns. Fair Isle is traditionally done using one yarn in each hand. This sounds intimidating, but it's easier than you think -- and far more addicting than you ever bargained for. This pattern *Fair Isle Headband* (shown page 8, lower right) will be provided by Kathy's Kreations and contains two different headbands. The first has just two colors, and the second amps up your skill with a few more!

On Sunday, we will talk mitered squares. "The project for this day will be open-ended, but we'll give you ideas for hats or scarves." Cynthia will have a general mitered-square handout for that day. The project is her *Four Corners Hat* (shown page 8, upper left).
